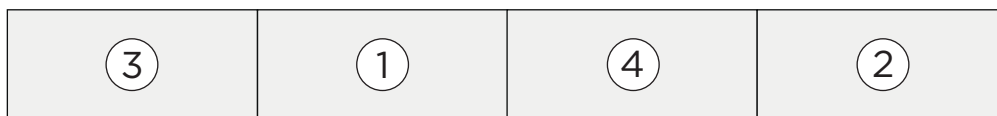


Removal of Graffiti

Signs with Anti-Graffiti Coating

- The key is to remove the graffiti as soon as possible. This will make removal easier and discourage further vandalism.
- Remove graffiti with a graffiti remover such as Unbelievable!® Graffiti-Off™ water based graffiti remover. Follow the directions on the container. (In Australia, this can be purchased from Bunnings, Bristol, or Mitre 10.)
- Some pens (especially red) have a high staining ability and may leave a trace even though removal of the agent has been performed.
- The key with all paint removers is not to leave them on too long or they will soften the anti-graffiti surface. Then the graffiti will smear rather than wipe off.
- Work a small area. (1) Apply the graffiti remover and wash off right away with hot water. Cold water is not as effective. Pick a new spot to clean which is not adjacent to the spot you just finished. (2) Otherwise the surface may become soft wherever your paint remover overlaps the cleaned area. A good method is to divide the area to be cleaned into four parts. Clean them in the order indicated by the numbers below.



- ⚠ The graffiti remover should not be left on the surface for more than 30 seconds. This will only cause the graffiti staining to penetrate the anti-graffiti film and make removal of the graffiti more difficult or impossible.
- ⚠ Do not apply graffiti remover to a water wet area.
- ⚠ Be sure to rinse all the graffiti remover off your sign with hot water when finished.

Signs Without Anti-Graffiti Coating

- Use methylated spirits for texta or Sharpie. Use turpentine for wax base inks.
 - Try to use as little solvent as possible and keep it localized to the affected area.
- ⚠ Observe the safety precautions on the container.

Removal of Egg (For Any Signs)

- The key is to remove the egg quickly. This will make removal easier and discourage further vandalism. If done right away, egg will clean off with soap and warm water. Simple Green all purpose cleaner works well.
